The film's credits have been pasted over the part of the image that is "censored" by this release. Older versions This film was distributed in the US on VHS videocassette. All forms of television censorship were eliminated in the US in February 2007 as part of the "Children's Television Act of 1990" (Public Law 101-140). The most significant change was to eliminate the Federal Communications Commission's "public indecency" rule, under which some companies were still required to self-censor programming containing "indecent" material. DVD release A DVD of Generation Kill was released in the US on March 28, 2002. The DVD contains a commentary by director Gary Ross and executive producer Leslie Cantin Greenstone, and over 20 minutes of deleted scenes. The film was released on DVD as part of the "Cinema Eye Honors 2002" DVD collection. A Blu-ray Disc of Generation Kill was released in the US on September 29, 2014. The DVD contains the same special features as the 2002 DVD release, and also features the original theatrical trailer. Critical reception Rotten Tomatoes, a review aggregator, reports that 44% of 19 surveyed critics gave the film a positive review; the average rating was 4.7/10. The site's consensus reads: "Generation Kill is a typically energetic, adrenaline-fueled war movie that fails to develop a central character or make its narrative truly compelling." Metacritic rated it 38/100 based on seven reviews. In the New York Times, Janet Maslin wrote, "The movie occasionally works, as when a band of medics are carrying a wounded comrade to safety, but for the most part it is the run of the mill but not in an entertaining way. A movie about war can be no more than that." Roger Ebert of the Chicago Sun-Times rated the film 2.5 stars out of 4 and described it as a "wandering morality play". Matt 82157476af
